The Active Aging and Social Activities Program is funded by the Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP), people over 65, wishing to join in these activities at the subsidised rate need to enrol through the My Aged Care system. The staff at Clota Cottage are more than happy to help you through the process.

People under 65 may be able to join in the activities and be subsidised through Victorian State Government HACC funding or as part of their NDIS plan.

If you are interested in joining any of these activities we have a come and try policy where the first session is free and if you like the program and wish to join we will start the enrolment process. The subsidised rate is charged once the enrolment procedure is started.
