Enrolment Information

Parents are requested to visit our service, where possible, to familiarize yourself and your child with the staff and facilities.

All parents/ guardians will be given a copy of our enrolment form, which we request to be filled out and returned prior to the child commencing childcare.

Up to date immunisation records, must be provided for your child. If immunisations are not up to date your child's enrolment will not be accepted as per the government 'no jab, no play' policy.

What to Bring

In a bag clearly marked with your child's name, bring:

- A healthy snack plus drink
- A change of clothes
- Nappies, wipes and a plastic bag for soiled nappies if needed
- Sun hat in summer and a jacket and warm hat in winter
- A sheet and blanket for rest time)

Child Care Sessions

Sessions are booked for the term and fees are required to be paid in advance.

Payment plans are available on request but are at the discretion of the Manager.
